Its high-resolution WUXGA (1920x1200) and 1000 nits brightness sunlight-readable display is perfect for those bright sunny days in the field. The unit is paired with an IP54 digitizer pen to ensure accurate touchscreen interaction. In addition, a quick-release function makes it easy to remove the tablet from the in-cab mount when it's quitting time.

T3RRA also appreciated the unit's many options and accessories – such as an optional ruggedized keyboard, docking station, in-cab 12V power adaptors and chargers, and more. RuggON also developed a pigtail to change the 12V to a 3-pin convenience outlet option, making the PX501 even better and more practical for many users.
